By bidding in the silent and live auctions, each bidder agrees to the following Auction Rules:

## **Bidder Number:**

At check-in, your number will be given to you with your auction catalogue booklet. The number is to be used in the silent and live auctions, and 50-50 Raffle

## **Auction Bidding:**

The silent auction is open from 6:00 to approx. 7:30 p.m. Three table closings will be announced five minutes prior to closing times. The minimum bid and minimum raise are printed on the bid forms for each item. Bids that do not meet the minimum raise are not valid. Enter your bid by writing your bidder number on the form opposite the amount you want to bid. You do not have to take the next available bid amount, but may skip ahead to the amount you want. The next bidder must bid higher than you to be successful. The last bid entry prior to closing will constitute the winning bid, unless a **Guaranteed Win** bid has been made.

## **Guaranteed Win:**

Most bid forms show a predetermined "Guaranteed Win" amount. If you wish to guarantee your purchase, you may do so by bidding the **Guaranteed Win** amount. Bidding on that item is concluded once a Guaranteed Win is entered.

*Northwest Chamber Chorus reserves the right to add or withdraw, without notice, items to or from the auction at any time.*

## **Purchasing:**

All items must be paid in full on May 1, 2010. Visa, Mastercard, cash and personal checks are welcome (American Express and Discovery cards are not accepted). Make all checks payable to the Northwest Chamber Chorus or NWCC.

To pay for your items, go to the cashier in the Conference Room upstairs and state your name and bid number.

You may pay for your purchases all at once at departure.

Pick up all gift certificates and tangible items from the check out table after you have paid the cashier.

All items purchased are final and there will be no exchanges or refunds on any item(s) unless otherwise noted.

The buyer is responsible for collecting and removing all purchases from the premises unless other arrangements are part of the offer.

NWCC has attempted in good faith to describe and catalogue all items correctly, but all items are offered "as is". # Northwest Chamber Chorus

The 2009-2010 concert season continues to be a great one, with three exciting programs and the release of a new Christmas CD titled *A Ceremony of Carols*. The Chorus celebrated Christmas this year with a program titled *Comfort and Joy*, followed immediately by a recording session for the new *A Ceremony of Carols* Christmas CD that the group just released this spring. March's *Poetic Voices* program featured Randall Thompson's *Frostiana* songs with poetry by Robert Frost. In June we'll collaborate with the Bellevue Chamber Chorus in performances of the *In Tribute* program. The concerts presented in Seattle and the Eastside, include Herbert Howell's sublime Requiem and other great double-choir masterpieces by Schumann and Rutter. In addition, each group will take the spot light for performances of their own.

Outreach activities keeps the Chorus busy appearing in special programs around the Puget Sound area. These include singing traditional carols in December at the 5th Avenue Plaza Building in downtown Seattle, performing at ACT Theatre as part of the Sister's Christmas Catechism show, and joining the Seattle Repertory Jazz Orchestra for a fourth appearance in the annual Duke Ellington Sacred Concert—a sold out show at Town Hall!

In its 42nd year of bringing the best choral music to audiences in the Puget Sound region, the Northwest Chamber Chorus continues to enjoy enthusiastic audiences and extensive support and praise from the arts community. The group has been featured regularly on KING FM and KUOW. The group offers five commercial CDs including *Wassail!*, *Songs of the Americas*, *Handel Coronation Anthems*, *Northwest Chamber Chorus Live!* double CD set, and *A Ceremony of Carols* released on April 30, 2010.

The Chamber Chorus has performed with the Seattle Symphony, Northwest Chamber Orchestra, Seattle Youth Symphony, Cascadia Brass, Spectrum Dance Company, Philharmonia Northwest, Baroque Northwest, Seattle Repertory Jazz Orchestra, and in 2007 participated in the American Masterpieces Choral Festival, appearing on the Benaroya mainstage with choral conducting legend Dale Warland and celebrated composer Morten Lauridsen. In honor of the group's 40th Anniversary, June 8, 2008 was declared Northwest Chamber Chorus Day by Seattle Mayor Greg Nickels.

The Northwest Chamber Chorus receives financial support from a variety of sources including individual donors, its annual Spring Benefit and Auction, and grants from the Mayor's Office of Arts and Cultural Affairs, Washington State Arts Commission, and King County's 4Culture.

**Mark Kloepper, Music Director** of the Northwest Chamber Chorus since 2006, earned a Masters of Music degree in Choral Conducting from the University of Washington, where he studied under Joan Conlon, Geoffrey Boers, and Peter Eros. He has also received training from Rod Eichenberger, Helmut Rilling, Alice Parker, Robert Shaw, Paul Hillier, Moses Hogan, Anton Armstrong and Peter Philips. Mark is director of the vocal music program at the prestigious School of the Arts in Tacoma.

# Fund A Need

## **Hire an orchestra and soloists for the performance of Ottorino Respighi's *Laud to the Nativity* December 2010 Concerts**

It has been five years since the Northwest Chamber Chorus performed with a professional chamber orchestra, and we are excited to present the beautiful *Laud to the Nativity* with orchestra by Italian composer Ottorino Respighi for our December 4 & 5, 2010 Christmas concerts in Seattle.

Ottorino Respighi's cantata *Laud to the Nativity* was composed in 1930 in the later years of the composer's life, on a text by the 13th century Franciscan friar Jacopone da Todi. In addition to three vocal soloists and chorus, the work is scored for a 10-piece wind orchestra (flutes, oboe, English horn, percussion and piano 4-hands).

Respighi's music has been described as "new old music". He brought to the forms, techniques, and melodic lines of early Italian music, his special gift for evoking poetic images and successfully combining the best of the Italian musical past with the luminous harmonies and orchestral colors of the present. He expressed a desire to compose music that would speak to the people of his beloved Italy, and that was beautiful and easy for ordinary people to accept and enjoy.

Total cost for hiring the orchestra and soloists will be approximately \$6000 and we thank you for helping to fund this important project!
